Independence - We make our own, well-informed choices.

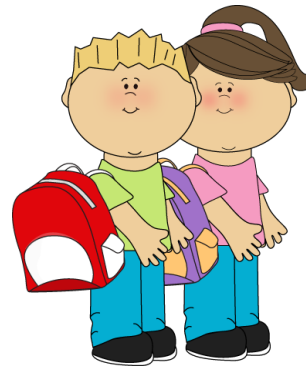


- * We select what we need to do and how best to do it.
